

MORE GUERNSEY PRACTITIONERS ADDED TO CITYWEALTH IFC POWERWOMEN LIST

The number of Guernsey practitioners featured in the [Citywealth](#) 2017 IFC Powerwomen Top 200 list has risen from last year.

Guernsey Finance Deputy Chief Executive Kate Clouston is one of those completing a hat-trick, having been named for the third year running. She is joined by 34 other women from Guernsey's business community, meaning the island has four more practitioners in the list than last year.
